

RECENT CRIME SCENE HIGHLIGHTS



Homeowner shoots and wounds robber

A couple inside a Cape St Francis house was attacked and during a scuffle a man grabbed his firearm and shot and wounded one of the suspects.

It is alleged that five men armed with crowbars and knives forced open the lounge window of a house in Waratah Avenue at 2.45 this morning, 5 September. The homeowner sustained minor injuries and was treated at the scene and his wife was uninjured.

Four other suspects fled the scene

and the wounded suspect ran a short distance but fell near the driveway. The 26 year-old, injured suspect was taken to hospital and is under police guard.

The SAPS says it is investigating a case of attempted murder house robbery after the incident. Police recovered a crowbar, cable ties and two stolen cell phones, one of which was in possession of the suspect.

Police say they are "hot on the heels of the other four suspects, who managed to flee the scene."

Four year-old killed in car accident

A four year-old child died after run allegedly been hit by a car when he ran across the road in front of it at 7.00 pm in the evening in Aston Bay.

An 88 year-old man driving a green BMW was arrested on a charge of driving under the influence of liquor and culpable homicide.

Police said detectives from the SAPS in Jeffreys Bay are investigating a case of culpable homicide following the fatal accident in which the child was killed.

It is alleged the driver was travelling from Aston Bay towards Jeffreys Bay. It is further alleged by the driver that

he noticed two young children standing on the side of the road. One of the children suddenly ran across the road and was hit by the car. The child passed away at the scene.

It was later confirmed that the name of child is Godfrey Junior Geswint. The driver was taken for a blood alcohol test and subsequently arrested.

The driver from Aston Bay is due to appear in the Humansdorp Magistrate's Court today, 31 August on the above charges. Investigations are continuing.

Man fatally stabbed at Hankey taxi rank

A 21 year-old man, Malivive Tilez, from Cofimvaba, was found dead near the Hankey taxi rank today after being stabbed today, 9 September.

The SAPS says the man's body was found with a stab wound in the chest and the police appeal for assistance

from the public in solving this murder case.
